

Case Study: Bromley MyTime



At one of the leisure centres under the wing of the Bromley MyTime charitable leisure trust, Carbon Credentials was asked to perform a Full Energy Survey.

Like many organisations, Bromley MyTime had seen a sharp rise in tariff prices and was keen to reduce their annual energy spend.

As the leisure centre was due for refurbishment, the brief was to identify energy-saving projects with short returns on investment, that could be

implemented quickly and that would not be affected by the refurbishment.

After a detailed on-site investigation in early 2009, 14 projects were identified, of which eight would show returns on investment within a year. The total value of savings was £71,000 – a saving of 19% on an annual energy bill of £366,000.
