

Case Study: Hammersmith Medicines Research



Hammersmith Medicines Research (HMR), a company that carries out medical research trials, recently relocated to premises in the Park Royal Estate in West London. Interested in reducing their carbon footprint, they called in Carbon Credentials.

Often when a company takes over a new building and it is in use for the first time, systems may not be set up to work optimally.

They needed an air conditioning inspection and when Carbon Credentials carried this out we identified a substantial number of areas where equipment was not operating at maximum efficiency.

HMR requested a Full Energy Survey to look at electricity and gas usage and the control strategy for the whole building. It was carried out with minimal fuss and disruption.
